Session times are subject to change once all entries have been received.

If the minimum number of entries is not received, those who have entered will be contacted after the closing date.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This competition will operate under the rules and regulations of the RSOBHD.
2. Dancers, parents, teachers and judges *must* observe the RSOBHD code of ethics.
3. Organiser reserves the right to refuse an entry or alter the program at their discretion.
4. In all cases, the adjudicators' decisions will be final.
5. The age of the competitor is as on the day of the competition.
6. All competitors must show current RSOBHD registration card before being allowed to compete.
7. Any dancer not ready when called shall forfeit entry in that event.
8. Entries will not be refunded unless the class is cancelled by the organisers.
9. Dancers compete at their own risk. The organisers accept no responsibility or liability for any loss or injury howsoever sustained, nor for any loss of property.
10. Dancers under 18 and all other children are always the responsibility of parents or guardians and should be appropriately supervised throughout the competition by them or another nominated adult.
11. Competitors changing status after the closing date should notify the organisers prior to the competition.

As an organiser we are trying to promote a Covid safe environment. For general advice on helping to prevent the spread of Covid, we recommend the following Scottish Government rules and guidance on how to stay safe. Covid is still a public health risk, and you can catch it even if you have been vaccinated or had it before. Participants should not attend the event if they are displaying any symptoms of Covid.

Choreography Competition Rules

- ◇ Music, theme, and costumes must be Scottish, Celtic or Nautical in style and can be instrumental or vocal. Songs must be sent electronically to the organiser prior to the event.
- ◇ Dance content should consist primarily of movements from Highland, National, Hornpipe or Jig books.
- ◇ All competitors must hold current registration cards with the RSOBHD at the time of the competition.
- ◇ Pre-premier dancers will not have their cards stamped in the event of winning and dancers will not be made to move up a category if they are competing with or against dancers of a higher category.
